## **ACCESS RULES FOR TRACK EXHIBITORS**

we would like to ask for your attention and cooperation in following a few simple rules that will make entering the Mostra Scambio orderly and faster for you.

## TRACK EXHIBITORS PASSES MUST BE COLLECTED AT AN ACCREDITATION

**CENTRE** located inside the **RIVAZZA** car park, exactly where you will have to go to enter the Exhibition.

The accreditation centre will observe the following **opening hours**:

- Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September from 8 a.m. to midnight
- Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> September from 6 a.m. and continuously until midnight on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September
- Saturday 9th September from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.

**Documents for collection:** pitch number and holder's identity card - in the case of collection by a proxy you must submit a photocopy of the pitch holder's identity card and written proxy (see Appendix A).

Once you have collected your passes, you must:

- Attach the car pass received to the inside of the windscreen, on the right hand side.
- Wear the exhibitor pass consisting of a non-removable bracelet on your wrist for the duration of the event and not transferable to others. (you will receive no.2 bracelets for each pitch).
- Go to the RIVAZZA parking area to wait for access to the track

Parking in the area in front of the accreditation centre <u>will only be permitted</u> for the time strictly necessary to collect admission tickets.

## Track exhibitors will only have access from the Rivazza entrance.

The entrance times for Track **exhibitors** will be as follows:

Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September – from **6 a.m.** Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> September – from 7 a.m. Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> September – from 7 a.m.

The entrance times for **visitors** will be as follows:

Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September – **from 11 a.m.** to 6 p.m. Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> September – from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> September – from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
